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# WHAT IS THE CAP PROJECT?

- The <u>CAP Project</u> is a study designed to help compare benefits from the Project PEAK to a group of typically developing preschoolers to see the effects of the program on a larger scale.
- Project PEAK is an early intervention program for caregivers with children ages 3-5 years old who are showing high levels of hyperactivity and/or inattention.
- By participating in this control group, you are helping other families all around the Lehigh Valley who are dealing with challenging child behaviors at home

# WHAT IS INCLUDED IN THE STUDY?

You and your child will be asked to participate in assessments which include the following:







# **QUESTIONNAIRES**

asking about your child's behavior and ADHD symptoms, your family, and your attitudes and behaviors toward parenting

## **OBSERVATIONS**

of you interacting with your child at home through zoom (30 min)

#### <u>ASSESSMENTS</u>

for your child in person at Lehigh University (approx 1.5-2hrs) assessing early literacy, numeracy, and self regulation skills

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### **ARE YOU ELIGIBLE?**

In order to determine eligibility...


### You (Primary Caregiver) will complete:


- Questionnaires asking about your child's behavior and ADHD symptoms, your family, and your attitudes and behaviors toward parenting.
- An interview with a Project PEAK staff member.

### Your child will complete:

- Assessment designed to measure cognitive ability.
  - This will last approximately 1.5-2 hours
  - o This will occur in person at Lehigh University

# **ASSESSMENTS OVER TWO YEARS**





### COMPENSATION

- If you complete all the assessments throughout the project, you will be compensated approximately **\$500** over the course of two years
- You will also receive <u>written reports</u> (after assessments 2-6) of your child's behavioral and educational progress
