The Office of Global Online Graduate Degrees and Training at Lehigh University has partnered with the Principals' Training Center (PTC) to offer Lehigh graduate credit for courses in Miami and London this summer.

M.ED. IN EDUCATIONAL LEADERSHIP

The M.Ed. in Educational Leadership degree is a 30 credit program designed to prepare professionals in school leadership. The program emphasizes management, curriculum, and administration. Special emphasis is placed on leadership in the international school setting. If you complete and transfer 3 PTC courses, it can take only 18 months to earn your M.Ed.

Included in the application are:

- A career aspiration essay, 1 page, double-spaced
- Two letters of recommendation
- Official transcripts from your undergraduate institution with a minimum undergraduate GPA of 3.0
- Application fee of \$65.00

Students will ONLY receive graduate transfer credit if they are officially accepted and enroll in classes at Lehigh University's College of Education.

All students in the M.Ed. in Educational Leadership degree program are required to attend a minimum of two (2) Summer Institutes at Lehigh University.



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FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS:

1) How many PTC courses can be transferred to Lehigh credit?

Up to three (3) courses may be transferred (not banked) towards a Masters Degree in Educational Leadership.

Approval of transfer credit is given only by the College of Education and the Lehigh Registrar.

2) How do I transfer PTC credits to Lehigh University's Master's Degree Program?

- Apply for admission, be accepted, AND enroll in the M.Ed. Program in Educational Leadership within four (4) years of completing your first PTC course.
- PTC courses will *only* appear on a Lehigh University transcript once you have successfully enrolled in and completed at least one College of Education graduate course.
- Request PTC Certificate of Completion.
- Complete request for Graduate Course Credit Transfer Petition.
